PTA Cinema Club

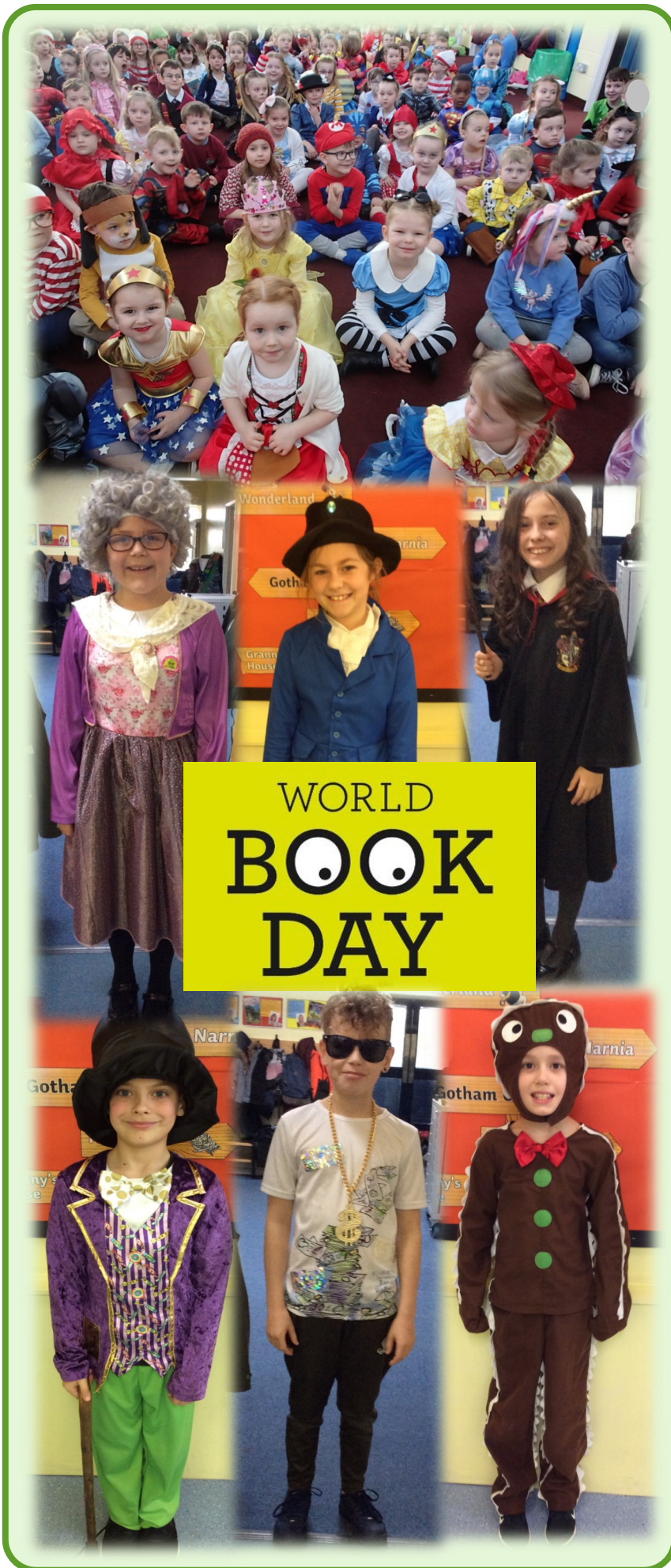
