








Year 3 Homework Challenge – Autumn 2nd 2023

We are delighted to send you our 'Homework Challenge' for this half-term. This will run alongside the regular English and maths that are set.

<p><u>Weather Diary</u> Record the weather over a week and put it into a chart. Can you measure how much rain falls? What kinds of clouds can you see? How much sunshine is there?</p> 	<p><u>Western Europe</u> Choose a country in Western Europe and make a fact file about it. Think about what makes that country famous and special. What landmarks do they have? What is the weather like? What language do they speak?</p>	<p><u>Mythical Creature.</u> Create your own mythical creature from Ancient Greece. You could draw it, sculpt it or write about it.</p> 
<p><u>Christmas around the world</u> Research how others celebrate Christmas around the world. Create a poster about all the different celebrations they do.</p> 	 <p>Activity of your choice linked to one of our curriculum units.</p>	<p><u>Textiles.</u> How many different fabrics can you find in your home? Make a list of them all and any fastenings you can find too. You could even take pictures for evidence!</p> 

The challenge work for this half-term is due in **Monday 11th December 2023** and during the week there will be time for each child to present their work and for it to be celebrated.

It is completely up to the children to decide how they want to record it. They could use photos, diagrams, drawings or something else! All we ask is that everyone has a go, so they all have something to share at the end of each half-term.
