







Year 1
Homework Challenge – Autumn 2 2023

We are going to be learning about lots of different topics and the following are all ideas that tie in with these:

<p><u>Science- animals and their needs</u> Choose 6 of your favourite animals. Can you name their offspring? Draw and label these.</p> 	<p>An activity of your choice.</p> 	<p><u>Maths</u></p> <p>Practice your number bonds to 10. Can you present them in an interesting way?</p> 
<p><u>Writing</u></p> <p>Write a recount of something exciting you have done recently. Did you do anything for Halloween? Bonfire night? Make sure you include time connectives- first, next, after that etc.</p>	<p><u>History – discovering history</u></p> <p>Make a family tree. Add some pictures.</p> 	<p><u>Art – children in art</u></p> <p>Create a mask. This can be any design you choose – which masks do you like? How can you make your own?</p> <p>Include primary and secondary colours.</p>

The challenge work is due in **Monday 18th December 2023** and during the week there will be time for each child to present their work and for it to be celebrated.

This work can be completed in their '*Challenge book*'. It is completely up to the children to decide how they want to record it. They could use photos, diagrams, drawings or something else! All we ask is that everyone has a go, so they all have something to share at the end of each half-term.
