









Year 1 Homework Challenge – Autumn 1st 2023

<p>Science- The Human Body We have been learning about our body and our senses. Make a fact file or information leaflet about the body or our senses. Add some diagrams or pictures too.</p> 	<p>An activity of your choice!</p> 	<p>Maths Counting forwards and backwards Practise counting forwards and backwards to 20 then 30. Can you count from different start numbers e.g. 12, 7.</p> 
<p>Pancakes! Make pancakes and write a recipe! What topping will you choose?</p> 	<p>Geography Can you draw a map of your route to school or perhaps a map of your garden? What buildings or objects can you add to it?</p> 	<p>Art and Design Can you paint a picture using warm or cool colours or even one of both?</p> 

The challenge work is due in on **Monday 16th October 2023** and during that week there will be time for the work to be celebrated. We will inform you of the date nearer the time and you can come into class to see what the children have done.

It is completely up to the children to decide how they want to record their work. They could use photos, diagrams, drawings or something else! You can upload it onto class dojo or send the work in. All we ask is that everyone has a go, completing at least one piece, so they all have something to share at the end of each half term.
