

Knowledge

Our focus for the knowledge sessions this half term is 'Air, Land and Sea'.

We will look at different methods of transport and decide which ones are best for certain journeys.

We will discuss if people have always travelled by cars and look at how transport has changed over time.

Finally we will consider different types of air travel, life boats and the transport in the fire service.

Maths

We will continue our focus of addition and subtraction from last half term. Focusing on adding by counting on and taking away by counting back.

We will then move onto numbers and place value. Focusing on counting patterns beyond 10 and building numbers beyond 10 (ten and how many more.)

Music

Our focus this half term will be 'Our World.' The children will learn the several different nursery rhymes and action songs and how to play musical instruments within these songs. They will listen and respond to different styles of music and have the opportunity to perform.



Art & DT

Our focus artist this half term will be 'Leonardo da Vinci'. We will look at his sketches of flying machines and machinery parts to inspire the children to draw designs of their own vehicles with pencils and note making.

P.S.H.E.

Our focus this half term will be 'Healthy me'. We will look at exercise and why this is important. We will discuss healthy food choices, sleep and keeping our body clean. We will also learn how to stay safe if we do not have an adult with us.
