 <p><u>Writing</u> Draw a picture of an animal and write some adjectives to describe it. How many adjectives can you think of? Can you write them in a sentence?</p>	<p><u>Geography</u> Can you draw a map of your route to school or perhaps a map of your garden? What buildings or objects can you add to it?</p> 	<p><u>Art and Design</u> Can you paint a picture using warm or cool colours or even one of both?</p> 

The challenge work is due in on **Monday 14th October 2019** and during the week there will be time for each child to present their work and for it to be celebrated.

It is completely up to the children to decide how they want to record it. They could use photos, diagrams, drawings or something else! All we ask is that everyone has a go, so they all have something to share at the end of each half-term.
