Our topic this term is 'Goodnight Mr. Tom' and the following are all ideas that tie in with the topic: These will mainly link to life during WW2.

<p>Make a small model of an Anderson shelter – no bigger than A4 so it's easy to put on display.</p>	<p>Food was short during WW2. Can you find any inventive WW2 recipes that made the most of what food was available? You could have a go at cooking one.</p>	<p>Food was also rationed. Can you make your own ration book?</p>
<p>.Dig for Victory! There were lots of posters made during WW2 to give the public tips about how they could help the war effort. Can you copy one or design your own?</p>	<p>Write a WW2 story. Perhaps your main character could be a pilot, an evacuee or even Winston Churchill.</p>	<p>During the battle of Britain planes flew overhead such as the Spitfire, Hurricane and Lancaster. Can you produce a picture or painting of one of these?</p>

The challenge work for Term 2 is due in **Monday 21<sup>st</sup> May 2018** and during the week there will be time for each child to present their work and for it to be celebrated.

We will send home a book for this work, should your child wish to use, which will be called their 'Challenge book'. It is completely up to the children to decide how they want to record it. They could use photos, diagrams, drawings or something else! All we ask is that everyone has a go, so they all have something to share at the end of each half-term.
