<p><b><u>Science</u></b></p> <p>Can you make or draw your own fossil? If you draw it, label it to show us what it tells us e.g. sharp teeth so it must have eaten meat.</p> 	<p><b><u>Geography</u></b></p> <p>Research the type of settlement you live in (city, town, village, or hamlet) and create a simple report or drawing to share with the class.</p> 	<p><b><u>Art</u></b></p> <p>Draw, paint or sketch an Egyptian pharaoh.</p> 
<p><b><u>Debating</u></b></p> <p><b>Should children be allowed to eat sweets every day?</b></p> <p>Write a short debate speech (3-4 sentences) explaining your point of view or have a debate with friends and family, record it and send it on dojo!</p>	<p><b><u>Eco Task</u></b></p> <p>Think of 3 ways you can save water at home or school (e.g., turning off the tap while brushing teeth, using a water-saving showerhead). Create a "Save Water" poster with your tips and some pictures to show others how to save water.</p>	<p><b><u>PE</u></b></p> <p>Research and present the rules of how to play netball.</p> 

The challenge work for this half-term is due in **Monday 9<sup>th</sup> February 2026** and during the week there will be time for each child to present their work and for it to be celebrated.
