Write a plan of how you will achieve your goal. What will help you to achieve it? What will you need to do or learn? How will you do it?</p> 	<p><b>Geography</b>    Create a fact file about The British Isles or one of the countries in it. You could include climate, urban and rural areas, famous landmarks and history.</p> 
<p><b>Art</b>    Create a portrait of a family member in any style you wish. For example, you could paint, sketch or collage and be inspired by one of the artists in our unit.</p> 	 <p><b>Activity of your choice</b>    Choose something that has interested you most this half term to celebrate and share with the class.</p>	<p><b>PE</b>    Can you design an invasion ball game that we can play in school?    You will need to come up with rules, scoring, teams and a layout for the game.</p>
