Knowledge

The focus for our knowledge sessions this half term is 'Light and Celebrations'.

We will learn about the Hindu festival of light, Diwali. We will make our own diva lamps with clay to take home.

We will also learn about Guy Fawkes and why we celebrate bonfire night.

After that we will look at day and night, weather and our changing seasons.

We will talk about how the daylight hours change as we move from Autumn to Winter.

Finally we will think about why people celebrate
Christmas.

Maths

We will be focusing on number and place value to begin with. We will then focus on addition and subtraction - looking at one more and one less. After that we will look at measurement and time. To finish the term, we will focus on number bonds to five.

Music

We will continue to learn familiar nursery rhymes and songs.
We will listen to a range of different songs such as 'Don't go breaking my heart' by Elton John and Kiki Dee and ending with Spiderman by Michael Bublé. The children will explore different movements to the music and keep a steady beat.



English
