We are delighted to send you our 'Homework Challenge' for this half-term. This will run alongside the regular English and maths that are set.

<p><u>The PSHE task</u></p> <p>Write a description of yourself in 20 years' time. Where would you like to be? What would you like to be doing?</p>	<p><u>The Science task - States of Matter</u></p> <p>Create your own ice lolly using different fruits and juices. Which one was your favourite?</p>	<p><u>The History task</u></p> <p>Build a model of HMS Victory using lego or recycled materials.</p>
<p><u>The Art and DT task</u></p> <p>Create your own Chinese inspired painting or sketch inspired by our learning.</p>	<p><u>The Geography Task</u></p> <p>Take a walk around your local area. This could be where you live or a trip to the beach. What human and physical features do you notice? You can record this with photos, sketches, scrapbook or PowerPoint.</p>	<p><u>The English Task – Tale of Fear</u></p> <p>Create your own story setting based on a tale of fear with annotations. You can represent this however you wish and then write a descriptive paragraph based on this.</p>

The challenge work for this half-term is due in **Monday 8th February 2026** and during the week there will be time for each child to present their work and for it to be celebrated.

It is completely up to the children to decide how they want to record it. They could use photos, diagrams, drawings or something else! All we ask is that everyone has a go, so they all have something to share at the end of each half-term.
