I am delighted to say that the new start times and allowing children to go into class from 8:30am has had a positive impact on how children settle in the morning. Our new breakfast club has also been a positive addition to the school, enabling children to come in from 7:30am and have a hot/cold meal to start the day. informed.

I would like to wish you all a very Merry Christmas and a Happy New Year.


