A reminder that for children's safety, no dogs are allowed on school premises under any circumstances.

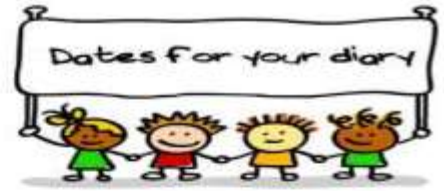


EYFS Official Opening
